In 2013, a number of interesting activities in the field of global education occurred:

- The educational program for children in preschool and primary school discovered stories from around the world. The stories were from different cultures, which originally were transmitted orally. This sparked the inspiration for a global appreciation.
- The educational program for youth from secondary schools included listening to women's voices. Students listened to the personal stories of women from Ghana, Guatemala and Poland collected in the book *Women Voices*. It has become a prelude to talks on women's rights in the broader context of human rights.
- Youth from secondary schools also reviewed images and news from the countries of the Global South. Under the guidance of teachers, they analyzed and critiqued the information appearing in the media.
- The film "Forbidden Education" inspired the educational program for young people from secondary schools.

The educational center hosts meetings, movies projections, workshops, and contemporary global issues (such as independent journalism, women's rights, minority rights and refugees, protection of the environment).
